

Grab 'N' Go Premium Mashed Potatoes

WHAT YOU NEED:

- 5 lb. bag Mrs. Gerry's Premium Mashed Potatoes
- Microwavable black containers (24 oz. or 16 oz.)
- #2 ice cream scoop or 4-5 oz. measuring cup
- Repack labels (either Mrs. Gerry's or store generated)



Mrs. Gerry's repack labels are available free of charge and mailed directly to you!

WHAT TO DO:

- For the 24 oz. containers, place 6 scoops of Mrs. Gerry's Premium Mashed Potatoes
- For the 16 oz. container, place 3 scoops of Mrs. Gerry's Premiium Mashed Potatoes
- Garnish with pads of unsalted butter and parsley, if desired
- Place next to Rotisserie or Fried Chicken or next to other dinner/side options in a refrigerated Grab 'N' Go case





HEATING INSTRUCTIONS

Mrs. Gerry's Mashed Potatoes are already cooked and just need to be heated to 165 - 180 °F before serving.

HEAT VIA MICROWAVE

- Step 1: Remove contents from bag and place in a clean microwaveable container.
- Step 2: Cover product to maintain moisture.
- Step 3: Microwave on HIGH for 2 minutes.
- Step 4: Stir.
- Step 5: Microwave on HIGH for an additional 3 minutes.
- Step 6: Stir.
- Step 7: Continue process until heated completely through, 165-180°F.

GUIDELINES FOR MAINTAINING PRODUCT QUALITY

UNOPENED PRODUCT

- Do not leave un-refrigerated (e.g. on dock).
- Store between 33° and 39°F.
- DO NOT OPEN until ready to use.

Note: Code date is valid only on products handled according to the above guidelines.

OPENED OR REPACKED PRODUCT

Note: The following is a regulation from the State Department of Agriculture and the State Board of Health.

- Mark "Opened Date" on bag when product is first opened. Count 7 days (including opening day) and mark on the bag "Dispose of Date". The product must be disposed of on that date.
- When repacking product, mark with a use by date of 7 days from the day you open it (including opening day)

OTHER OPENED PRODUCT HANDLING GUIDELINES

- Return to the cooler (in corrugated case) as soon as possible.
- Practice good hygiene. Wash hands with approved sanitizing hand cleaner.
- Sanitize utensils used for serving or re-packing product with 50 PPM chlorine, or 12.5 PPM iodine sanitize solution (1 teaspoon chlorine bleach per gallon water = 50 PPM chlorine).
- Containers to be used for repacking should be stored where they are protected from contamination (e.g. sealed with plastic bags).
